Common features & observations

- Strong in pointing out the relevance of indicators, monitoring etc. for comprehensive local-level integration policies
- Recommendations tend to be on a general level
- Overall rather descriptive, esp. in case studies
- No systematic comparative evaluation of city practices
- No substantial evidence for cross-country policy learning on the level of concrete indicators, creation of monitoring systems and other practicalities
- Few real how-to-do tools & implementation guidance
